

Blue Heron: A delicious example of Michigan's cool climate white wines: lovely aromas of peaches, melons and citrus blossom dominate. Delicate flavors of pear, mango and lychee overlay a crisp acid structure that focuses the wine and leads to a long, satisfying finish. Made with the addition of reserve juice, the naturally low alcohol content and luscious fruit flavors appeal to a broad spectrum of wine lovers.

Appellation: Lake Michigan Shore Acid: 6.8 • pH: 3.50 • RS 5.0% • A.B.V. 9%

Red Heron: The deep red color, fresh grape aroma, and unforgettable flavor are at their best thanks to Michigan's cool climate. Big, rich and powerful cherry, grape jam and candied fruit aromas run through the strawberry and lemon drop flavors. Hints of guava dance in the background. The crisp acidity nicely balances the semi-sweet, refreshingly tart finish. Enjoy this softly sweet, lightly fruity, easy-drinking wine - chilled, on the rocks, or with a splash of soda. Red Heron is the wine for all occasions.
